

5.0 Web Polls

The Web Poll module is a simple application designed to produce and present a single question poll with up to 7 possible responses. Although any number of polls can be produced, the module is setup to present only one poll at any time. Polls are displayed on the FoxSuite homepage so that all users can access the poll and enter a single vote. Once a user enters their single vote the poll screen changes to a results screen and remains in this configuration effectively blocking possible multi-voting.

Note: The polls module uses “cookies” to prevent multiple voting by a single user. It is important to understand that this system is only a minimum protection measure, as a user can easily revote after clearing “cookies” from their computer.

The Poll module can be accessed only through the Homepage customization page by clicking the small purple button next to the Poll presentation type as shown below.
